The Terryville Youth Soccer Club (TYSC) will hold walk in registrations for the spring soccer season on **Friday, February 21st** and **Friday February 28th** from 6:30PM to 8:30PM in the Senior Lounge at the Plymouth Town Hall. And for those of you who would rather, you may also register via our web-site www.tyscsoccer.com. Registration forms can be printed in **Word** or **.pdf** formats that can be filled out and then mailed to the club P.O. Box. The web-site also posts our club meeting dates and times, club events, pictures and much more soccer related information.

⚽ **The spring season begins on April 5th (Division 2 travel), April 6th (Division 1 travel) and on April 13th for our in-town teams.**

TYSC offers a variety of Youth Soccer levels:

TYSC organizes in-town as well as travel soccer teams. For calendar year 2002, TYSC had 388 children play spring or fall soccer, and most played both. This spring season TYSC will be fielding the following teams. Here is a brief description of each level.

In-town soccer teams: from 4 to 16 year old boys and girls form teams and play Sunday afternoons at one of our town soccer fields. This last fall our in-town teams were organized as follows:

U5 – four (4) teams

U7 – four (4) teams

U11 – four (4) teams

U15 – two (2) teams

Division 2 travel soccer teams: Teams travel to area towns (for away games) in the North West section of Connecticut, in an area from Wolcott to Salisbury and from Winsted to Danbury. Division 2 teams play on Saturdays. Players must live in the town(s) where the club is registered.

This spring TYSC will field the following division 2 teams:

U10 boys – coached by Jane Dorosh

U13 boys – coached by Paul Dorosh

U14 girls – coached by Judy Malinowski

Division 1 travel soccer teams: These are the higher skill level town travel teams. Traveling to the same area towns in the North West section of Connecticut as Division 2. Division 2 teams that win their NW district division are required to move up to Division 1 play. Division 1 teams play on Sunday afternoons after 1PM. Players must live in the town(s) where the club is registered.

This spring TYSC will field the following Division 1 teams:

U11 girls – coached by Jeff Anderson

U16 girls – coached by Rich Lyga

State League soccer teams: This is the highest level of soccer in Connecticut, and these teams have no residency restrictions as in Division 1 or 2 town travel teams. State League teams also have divisions 1, 2 and 3 groupings, with 1 being the highest. There are only 5 Division 1 State league teams (per age group) in Connecticut. Division 1 and 2 State League teams play anywhere in the state. Division 3 State league teams must play in their districts against Division 1 town travel teams until they win their district and move up to Division 2 State League play.

This spring TYSC will field the following State League teams:

U18 Division 1 - boys – coached by Don Murphy

U18 Division 3 - boys – coached by Galen Boucher

TYSC would like to encourage more of our in-town parent coaches to start a travel team, contact Rich Lyga for more information and how to start a travel team.

U11 Girls go 8-0!!

Congratulations to our U11 Division 2 girls travel team and coach Jeff Anderson who went undefeated this past fall. The girls won the NW District U11 division with an 8-0 record and will be moving up to Division 1 play this spring. The team members received trophies at the NW District awards banquet held at the Amber Room in Danbury in January.

Coaching Report

TYSC will continue our commitment to the children of this community by again hiring professional coaches for the spring 2003 season. “The Dutch Sports Academy LLC” will assist in coaching our spring soccer programs and hold coaching clinics for our parent coaches. These coaches from the “Dutch Sports Academy” are provided by TYSC at no additional cost to the players or parents, and are paid for through corporate donations and our TYSC Terryville Fair Soccer booth precedes.
