Congratulations to our U14 Division 2 girls (coach Terri LaPan) and U16 Division 1 girls (coach Rich Lyga) travel teams. These girls won their respective North West District CJSA divisions. The U14 girls ended the season with a 7-0-1 record and the U16 girls ended the season with a 5-2-1 record. The team members received trophies from the CJSA NW District. This is the first time that TYSC has had two (2) division champions in a single season.
