Fall 2005 Travel Teams:

In addition to our in-town soccer programs played at Hancock field, our club will be fielding three (3) travel teams this fall.

Boys Teams: U10 division 2 team coached by Bob Brown and a U13 division 2 team coached by Jane Dorosh.

Girls Teams: U14 division 1 team coached by Jane Dorosh.

Spring 2005 Travel Teams results:

U19 Division 1 Girls: Coach Rich Lyga.

This group of girls, all of which play on the Terryville High School varsity soccer team, played in a competitive 11 team grouping of U19 division 1 teams. The girls finished a 10 game season tied for 5th place posting 3 wins, 5 losses and 2 ties.

U13 Division 1 Girls: Coach Jeff Anderson.

Congratulations are once again in order for this group of girls who once again finished as the first place team in their division. This spring season they finished as the U13 division 1 champions with a record of 7 wins, 2 losses and 1 tie. This team competed in an 11 team grouping consisting of U12 and U13 teams, 4 of which were U13 teams. Danbury U12 was the winner in the 7 team U12 section of this group.

U16 Division 1 Boys: Coach Paul Dorosh and Joe Northrop

This U16 boys team had a good spring season and were able get some valuable experience playing against some good teams prior to entering high school this fall. This was a young group of boys, previously playing division 2 soccer, and coming into a competitive 7 team U16 division 1 grouping. The team came in last place with 0 wins and 8 losses.

U12 Division 2 Boys: Coach Jane & Coach Tom

These boys and girls (this is a co-ed team playing in the boys division) did an awesome job working together as a team this spring. The team posted 3 wins, 4 losses and 1 tie giving them a 4th place finish in this 8 team group.

U9 Division 2 Boys : Coach Bob Brown

The U9 team had a great second season together playing in a 9 team group and look forward to the fall soccer season. U9 and U10 travel teams in our Northwest CJSA district do not keep win/loss records.

Hancock Field Improvements for 2005:

With grants obtained through the Main Street Community Foundation, the Thomaston Savings Bank Foundation and funds given the club from the Plymouth Chamber of Commerce Golf Tournament, our club has purchased a new Victorian style 14 x 16 storage shed (\$5000.00). The shed will be used to store the club's tee-shirts and equipment, and will serve as our future concession stand. We are also in the process of getting an electrical feed and phone service to our Hancock soccer field. The improvements at Hancock field will continue with the construction of a soccer kick board and the purchase of a John Deere lawn tractor (the tractor will help in the pick-up of the goose droppings).

Annual Pizza and Awards Party:

The annual pizza and awards party will be held at the Terryville High School on December 13th from 12 noon to 2:00 PM. This is a free event for all spring and fall players as well as their families. The gym will be open and set-up for indoor soccer and basketball. There will be a collection for the Plymouth Food Pantry of non-perishable foods.
